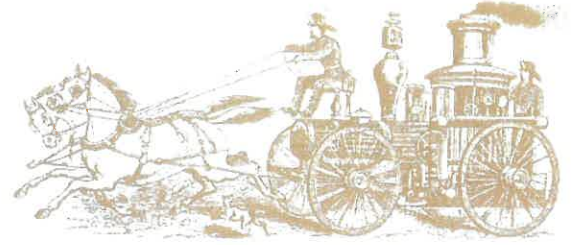


# GEORGETOWN FIRE DISTRICT



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## RESOLUTION 2017-02

### RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GEORGETOWN FIRE DISTRICT, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF FIRE SUPPRESSION ASSESSMENTS WITHIN THE GEORGETOWN FIRE DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017/2018

The Board of Directors of the Georgetown Fire District, California (hereafter referred to as Board of Directors) hereby finds, determines, resolves and orders as follows:

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Directors desires to levy and collect assessments against parcels of land within the District for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018, to pay the costs and expenses of operating, maintaining and servicing fire suppression services and appurtenant facilities located within the District; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Directors has previously conducted a successful property owner protest ballot proceeding for all District assessments proposed to be levied, and said assessments are described in the approved Engineer's Levy Report, and the assessments as described comply with all applicable provisions of the California State Constitution Article XIII D.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE DISTRICT, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1** Following notice duly given, the Board of Directors has held a full and fair Public Hearing regarding its Resolution approving the levy and collection of assessments, and considered all oral and written statements, protests and communications made or filed by interested persons. The Board of Directors has determined that the property owners in accordance with the requirements of the California State Constitution, Article XIII D have approved the assessments so presented.

**Section 2**

Based upon its review (and amendments, as applicable) of the Engineer's Levy Report, a copy of which has been presented to the Board of Directors and which has been filed with the Secretary of the Board, the Board of Directors hereby finds and determines that:

- a) The land within District will receive special benefit by the operation, maintenance and servicing of fire suppression services and appurtenant facilities within the boundaries of District.
- b) District includes all of the lands receiving such special benefit.
- c) The net amount to be assessed upon the lands within the District is in accordance and apportioned by a formula and method which fairly distributes the net amount among all eligible parcels in proportion to the special benefit to be received by each parcel from the improvements and services for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018.
- d) Such assessment shall be \$56.52 for each unimproved parcel and \$65.92 for each parcel with improvements thereon.

**Section 3**

The Report and assessment as presented to the Board of Directors and on file in the office of the Secretary of the Board are hereby confirmed as filed.

**Section 4**

The Board of Directors hereby orders the proposed improvements to be made, which improvements are briefly described as the maintenance, operation, administration and servicing of fire suppression services within the Georgetown Fire District service area and all appurtenant facilities related thereto.

**Section 5**

The maintenance, operation and servicing of fire suppression services and appurtenant facilities shall be performed pursuant to the Code and the County Auditor of El Dorado County shall enter on the County Assessment Roll opposite each parcel of land the amount of levy, and such levies shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the County taxes are collected. After collection by the County, the net amount of the levy shall be paid to the Georgetown Fire District.

**Section 6**

The Georgetown Fire District shall deposit all money representing assessments collected by the County for the District to the credit of a fund for the Georgetown Fire Suppression Assessment, and such money shall be expended only for the maintenance, operation and servicing of fire suppression services and appurtenant facilities as described in Section 4.

**Section 7**

The adoption of this Resolution constitutes the levy for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018.

**Section 8** The Secretary of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to file the levy with the County Auditor upon adoption of this Resolution.
